ABOUT THE PRESENTATION

Mr. Anoop K T (Structural Engineer, Agrico Designs) discussed about the topic "SPACE FOR HEALTHY LIVING". It was really interesting and informative especially for those who are budding civil engineers. The session shed light on how to provide a healthy living environment around us.

He first introduced us to Sick Building Syndrome (SBS) which is used to describe situations in which building occupants experience acute health and comfort effects that appear to be linked to time spent in a building, but no specific illness or cause can be identified. So, health should be uncompromised and it becomes necessary to ensure it. Thus, a

designer needs to look various factors- respiratory health, thermal health, vision health, hearing health and posture health. As a civil engineer, it is our part to consider each and every factor to maximize healthy environment.

Respiratory health is ensured by providing proper circulation of air, proper ventilation (which includes both natural and artificial ventilation), maximize the open spaces, by air filtering or cleaning methods, by avoiding the air contaminations, by control of humidity inside the building and by treating the Volatile Organic Components (VOC). The windows and doors should be opened often to flush out the impure air inside the rooms. We should always use materials or appliances with low VOC emissions and also use the help of interior plants to keep the inside air fresh.

Performance of the building users is directly depended on the thermal factor, i.e. the occupant productivity decreases when the temperature inside the building is too hot and too cold. Thus, the thermal health of people can be ensured by proper control and insulation of outside temperature to inside. The ventilation should be designed also taking the size of room the number of occupancy and the functions inside the room into consideration. The sun direction and the sunlight should be adequate. The sunlight should be utilized effectively when in need and need to be insulated when not in need.

Light is provided by both natural and artificial lighting elements. The natural light is less dangerous to a naked eye. But still, we should provide insulation from UV radiations from sun. The glare inside building should be reduced and intensity of light should be optimum. By green certification, the light glare should be less than 10 %. The light

intensity inside the building should be between 300 lux and 3000 lux. DIALux is software used to control the material reflection and intensity of light. The intensity limit varies from different working spaces: Bedrooms - 300 lux, Kitchen – 500 lux, commercial area – 500 lux. For a good working condition, warm light are well suited.

The acoustics of a room or other indoor space plays a crucial role in how easily and comfortably you can hear. It creates lack of concentration and acoustic discomfort. Background noises, echo, reverberation etc. are major causes. Noises can be reduced by noise filters and acoustic filters can be used to bring echo and reverberation to the minimum level. The noise intensity that should be provided inside the room depends on the materials used, furniture's inside room, size and shape of room, number of windows provided, etc.


Posture health is how the body movements is aligned with the design of the house. For example, at what height the kitchen cabinets and countertops should be provided. The things should be placed and designed as suitable to every member – irrespective of age and size.
